The 2026 Turner Group Scholarship is open to New Hampshire high school seniors planning to study **architecture** or **engineering** (civil, structural, environmental, mechanical, etc.) at a post-secondary school (college, university, or technical school) upon graduation. Students are not required to attend post-secondary school in New Hampshire in order to qualify for the Turner Group Scholarship, but must graduate from a high school in New Hampshire.

The Turner Group will award two (2) \$1,000 scholarships in 2026: an architecture scholarship and an engineering scholarship. Recipients must have proof of acceptance to their school of choice to receive the award.
